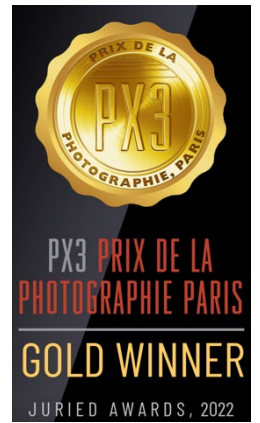


## Artworks from Series „Edge of the Wave” (2021-2022)

## Artworks from Series „The Hidden World” (2023)

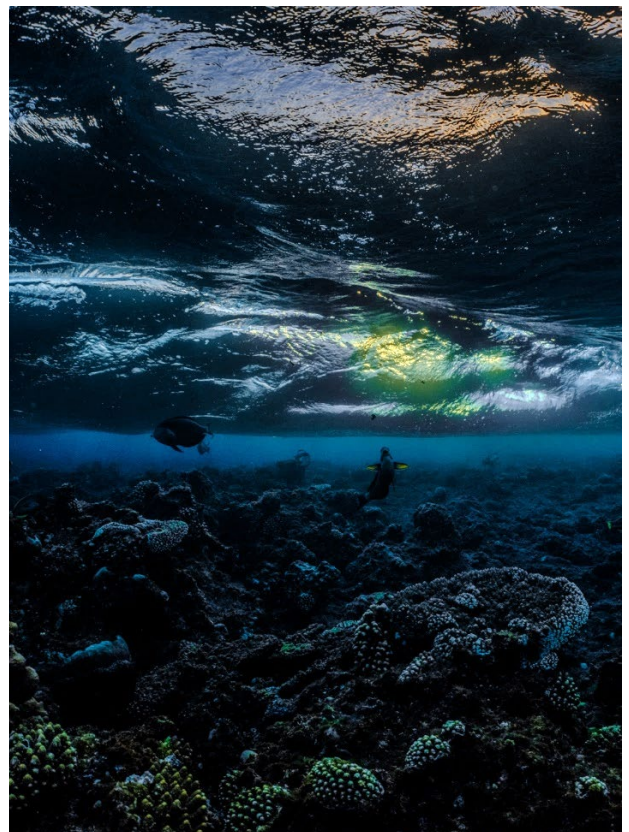
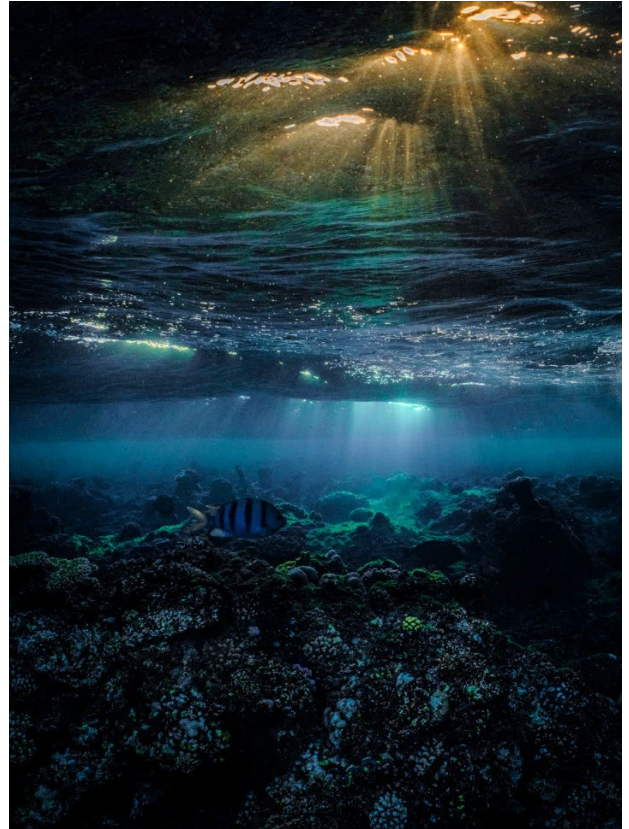

## Artworks from Series „Sundown Underwater” (2023)

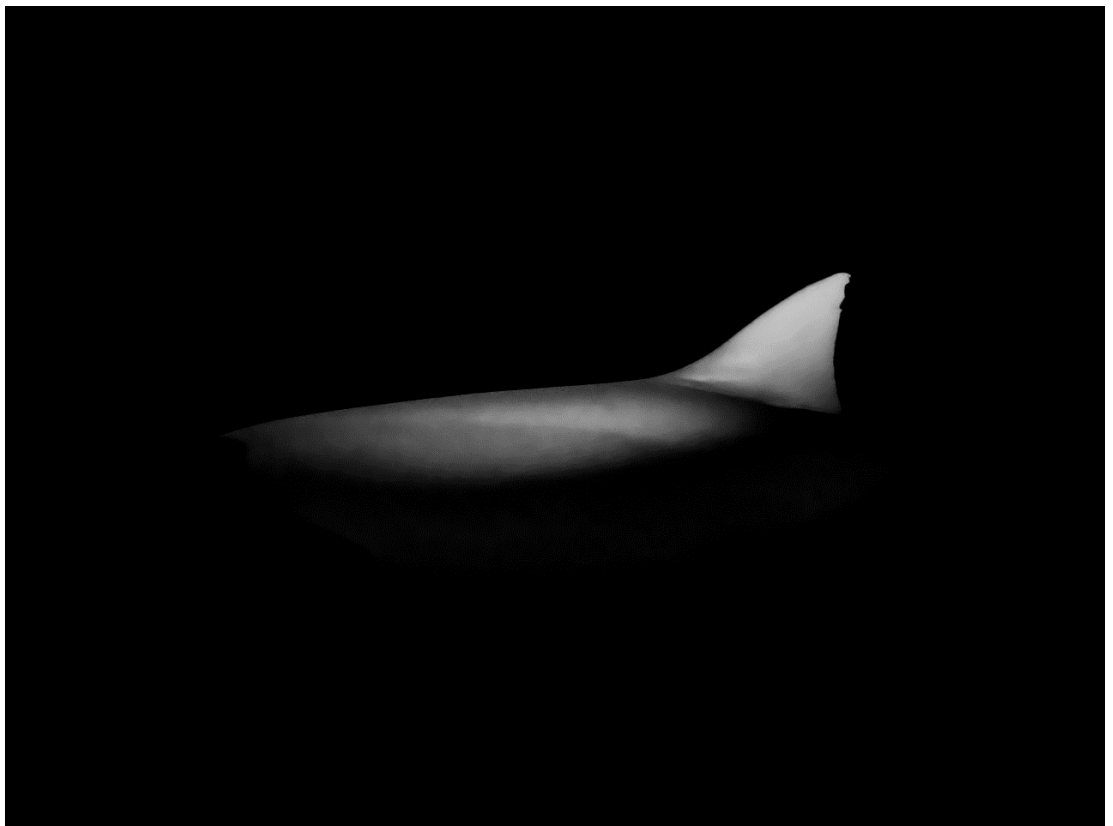
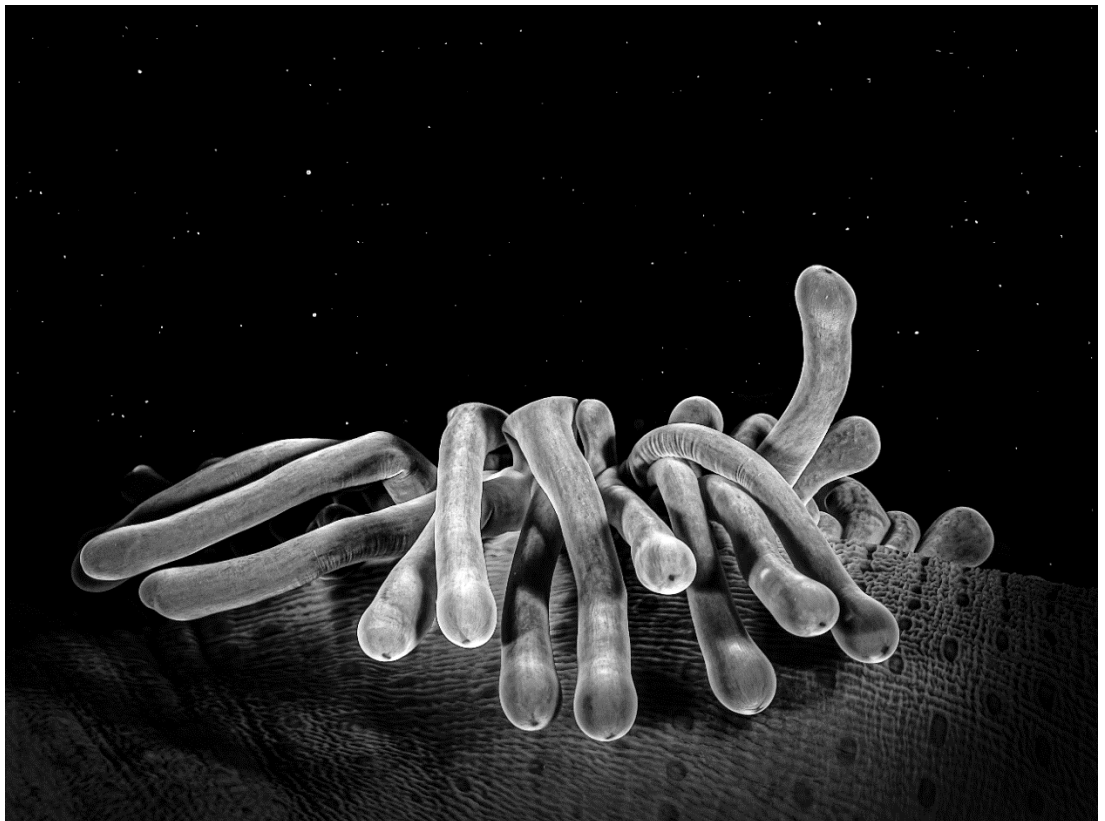


The pictures are captured below the water's surface as the day fades. At those quiet moments, time feels suspended. The gentle play of sunset light intertwines with life's simple rhythms.

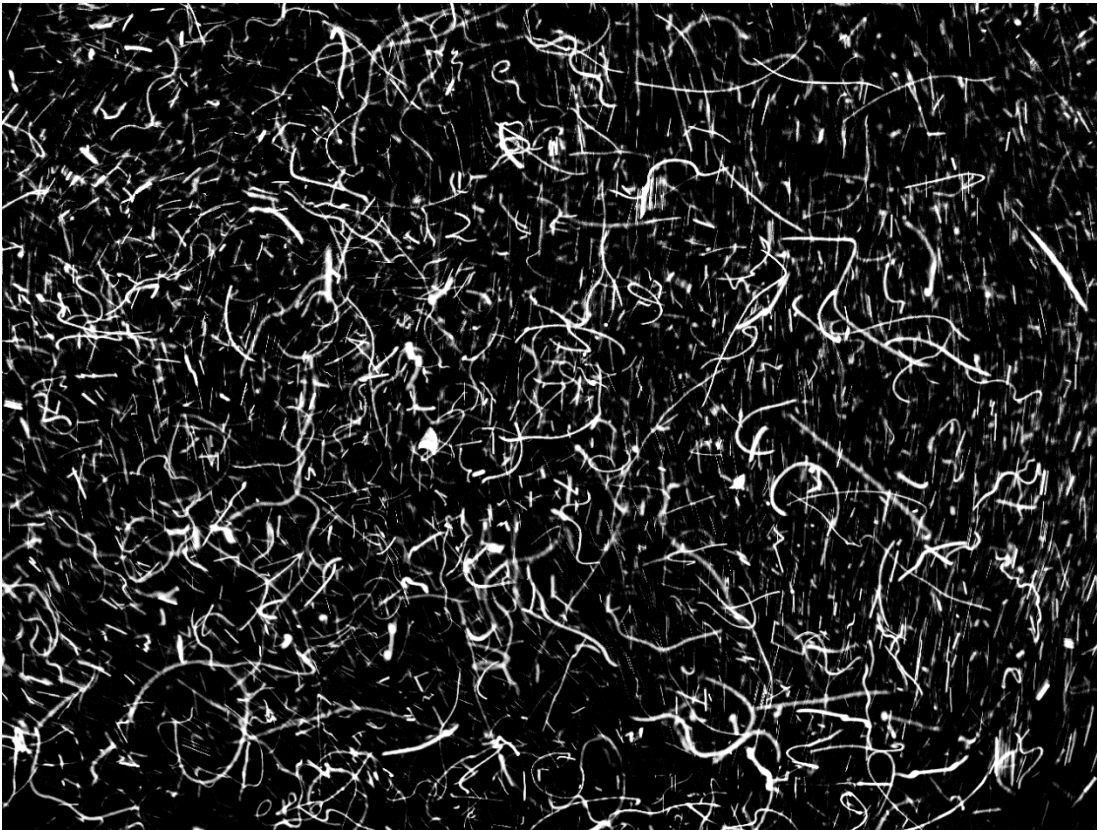


**Emerging from the enigmatic depths, marine species form intriguing silhouettes against the dark canvas of the underwater universe.**

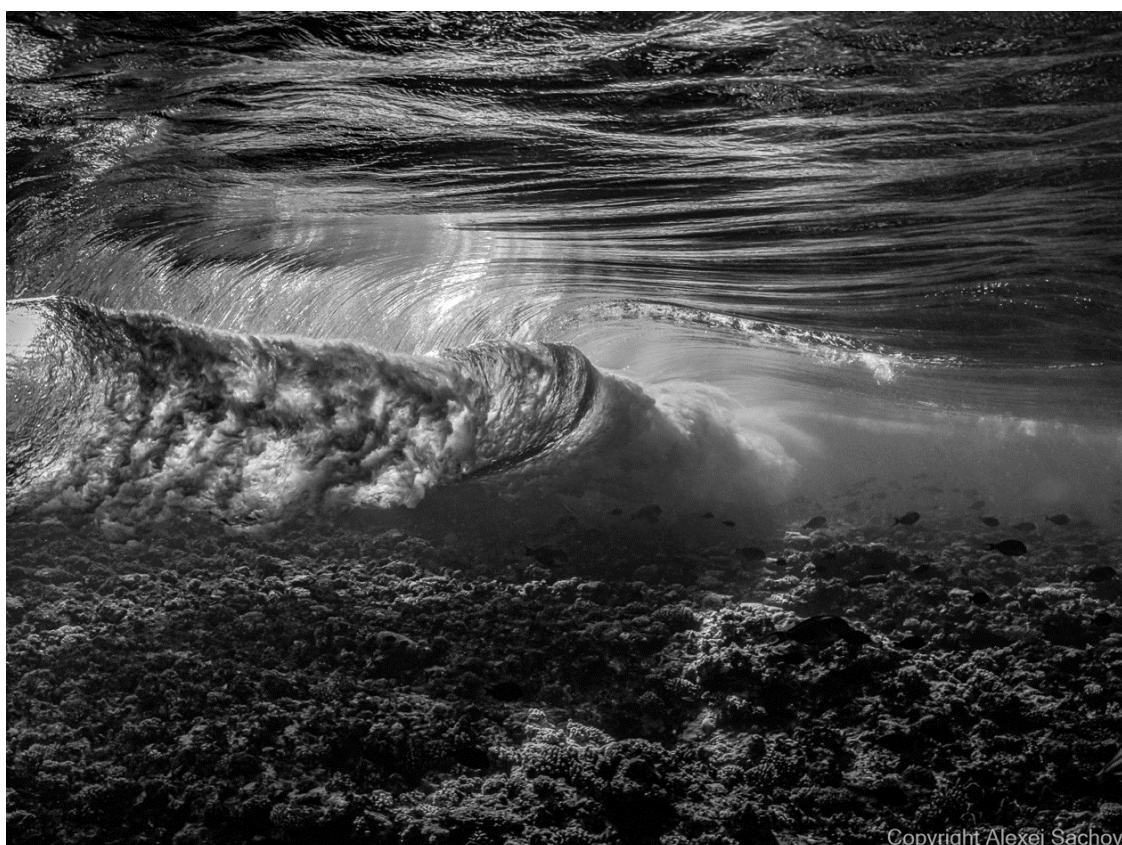


**Plankton and small fish are moving fast at night. A battle dance between hunters and prey. The traces that remind of the battle resemble a galaxy, like ours.**

art styles to underscore the link between terrestrial and aquatic worlds. With his distinctive style, he aspires to elevate underwater photography to powerful contemporary art that advocates for peace and environmental protection.
